



What is COVID-19?

COVID-19 is a disease caused by a new coronavirus, which has not been previously identified in humans.

How does COVID-19 spread?

COVID-19 appears to spread most easily through close contact with an infected person. When someone who has COVID-19 coughs or sneezes, small droplets are released and, if you are too close, you can breathe in the virus.

What is the treatment for COVID-19?

There is no currently available treatment or vaccine for COVID-19. However, many of the symptoms can be treated.

Who is most at risk?

Older people, and people with other medical conditions, such as diabetes, heart disease and lung disease, appear to be more at risk of developing severe disease.
